

- Outdoor sports shoes must be removed before entering the building and cleaned on the brushes provided.
- Only indoor sports shoes are permitted in the Sports Hall, unless prior permission has been granted.
- No food or drink is to be taken into the Hall.
- Boys **must** not enter equipment cupboards without prior permission from staff. Under no circumstances should boys change clothes in the stores.
- Boys may change during breaktimes provided they have proved trustworthy and understand the limitation imposed by the School.
- No jewellery/watches should be worn during lessons/activities in the Sports Hall. In order to improve security for students' valuables at School and at Grist, secure lockers have been installed in the Sports Hall and Grist, and each boy will be asked to buy a special padlock from the School Shop which he will own and use throughout his time at Tiffin. Students should be aware that these lockers are only for use while they are involved in PE, Games or Sports Practices, and items can not be left in them afterwards. The lockers will be regularly checked and cleared (any items left behind will go to Lost Property). We have introduced this facility due to the number and value of expensive items that the students now bring into school. I would appreciate if you would support us on this issue and discuss with your son the necessity of bringing such items to school in the first place. The responsibility for the safety of these items will now reside with the student.
- On entering the Sports Hall, students should sit down and await the arrival/instructions of the teacher.
- Students must wear clean and appropriate clothing.
- No physical activity should take place without the permission of, and supervision by, a teacher. Students should not use any apparatus in the Hall unless told to do so by a teacher.
- Students should keep the Sports Hall clear of dirt and rubbish.
